

While I Have My Being

Psalm 104:33 I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.

Psalm 146:2 While I live will I praise the LORD: I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being.

Here we see the psalmist longing to Praise the Lord while he is able to. Life is short and our opportunity to serve the Lord is even shorter.

Three things we must do while there is time!

1. Saved while it is the Season

Jeremiah 8:20 “The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved.”

The time for salvation will come to an end. You will not always have the chance to accept Christ.

Genesis 6:3 “And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man,…”

2. Labor while there is Light

John 9:1-5 And as *Jesus* passed by, he saw a man which was blind from *his* birth. And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him. I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. **As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.**

Matthew 5:14 “**Ye are the light of the world.** A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.”

3. Praise while we have the Physical ability.

We will not always be able to serve the Lord and praise His name. There will come a time when our body will be weak and frail. While we have our being we will praise HIM.

4. Give our Best while we have our Breath.

Ecclesiastes 9:10 *Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.*
